▪ **Three Recommendation Letters** You will need to submit the contact information of three recommenders who can write letters that support your application. Recommenders must have knowledge of your proposed project, your professional career, and your contributions to the field. Recommenders should also be able to speak to your non-professional qualifications as well and your ability to communicate and interact with an

international community who primarily converse in English. Once you submit your application, recommenders will be contacted via email so they may submit their recommendation letters. Please ensure that recommenders are able to respond via email and are able to submit recommendation letters within two weeks of the published competition deadline.

■ **Additional Published Work/Review** You have the option to attach additional published work that would help support your application. You may submit up to three samples. Please combine all published reviews including translations into one single document to upload to the application.
