REQUIREMENTS

- **Project Summary** (250 words) written for a general audience. This information will be inserted into a text field in the online application. It should address the purpose and goal of the project and specify the stage of the project you propose to complete while at Bellagio. An anticipated work plan for the time at Bellagio should be included.
- **Project Proposal** (not to exceed 1250 words) indicating its purpose and goals. If relevant, please include a draft chapter or brief outline (Note: this will be included in the 1250 word limit).
 - Overall description of your project with particular attention to the phase of the project you will be working on during your time at Bellagio
 - Detailed information on the scholarly and/or global context of your work and how your project is innovative or distinct from other work in your

field

- Potential impact of your project within your field and/or impact on the lives of poor and vulnerable people, if applicable.
- Specific short-term outputs and/or intended long-term outcomes of your project
- Details on the target audience and the planned means of dissemination
- Specific and clear outline of your work plan for the time at Bellagio
- If possible, please include a draft act/chapter/section or brief outline of your work, book, or publication (Note: This will count towards the 1250 word limit).

- **Abbreviated CV** (no more than 4 single-spaced pages) with career highlights, including publications and awards. *Please do not submit professional biographies.*
- **Work Sample** one chapter or article (20 page maximum) published in the last five years. If none of your previous work is published in English, please provide either an English translation or an English summary of the work sample.
- **Three Recommenders** with knowledge of your project and your professional career and contributions to the field. They must be able to respond via email. (See the FAQs for more information)
- **Published Reviews** (maximum of 3 reviews). This is optional. Please combine all published reviews including translations into one single document.
- **Former Bellagio Residents** must submit a statement of no more than 250 words describing what was accomplished during the previous residency, indicating the specific output and/or outcomes, the critical response, and what has been accomplished since then.
- Due to the high volume of applications, we are not able to review any additional documents.
